## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Is there a weight/height/age restriction?**

In the UK, the minimum age for a tandem skydive is 16. If you're under 18, a parent or guardian must also sign the required forms. The maximum weight (fully clothed) is 210 pounds (15 stone, 95kg) for those over 5ft4in (163cm), or 182 pounds (13 stone, 82.6kg) for those 5ft4in or less.

### **Will I receive any training before I jump?**

You will receive a safety briefing with an instructor before you jump. They will cover all aspects of the skydive with you including the equipment and what to expect. This can take approximately 10 – 15 minutes.

### **How safe is the equipment?**

Skydive Langar uses the most modern equipment on the market. Tandem parachute systems have two parachutes: a main and a reserve. The main parachute is packed by packing certificate holders who have been checked out on each system.

### **Can I have my Skydive filmed?**

Yes, the company provides a video and photo package option. An experienced videographer will follow you in freefall wearing a video and stills camera on their helmet to catch the skydiving action. The cost is £85 which needs to be pre-booked via our website. Personal go-pros are not allowed.

### **Can I do an additional jump on the day?**

Yes you can, for an additional £130.00.

### **What do I need to pay?**

Your non-refundable registration fee will need to be paid at the time of booking. The balance of the minimum fundraising total needs to be paid to Beaumont House two weeks prior to the jump. Any additional fundraising can be paid to us at any time. This can be made easier by setting up JustGiving page for your skydive. The funds will then come directly to us and we can claim Gift Aid for those who can.

### **Can Beaumont House help me with my fundraising?**

Fundraising support will be provided, so don't worry we will help you to achieve your target amount.

### **Can my friends and family come to watch?**

The airfield has a large spectator area for your friends and family to watch you in action. There is also a Café onsite available to purchase food and drinks.

### **Can I jump with my glasses on?**

Yes of course. You will be provided with goggles that will comfortably fit over your glasses and can be adjusted to tighten.

### **Does a tandem skydive feel like a rollercoaster?**

This is a very common question and expectation of what people perceive skydiving to feel like. That sinking feeling in your stomach when you're on a ride is what most people are expecting to feel when they leave the plane. Surprisingly, there is no sense of this, not even a sense of falling. Skydiving feels more like flying, floating through the air even when you are falling at an average of 120mph!
